COLOSSEUM



Probably the most famous monument in the Italian capital, the Colosseum is the starting point for your tour. This ancient arena, with a capacity of more than 50,000 spectators, is the largest amphitheater in the Roman world.

So much blood was shed in these arenas, where the famous gladiator fights, animal fights and Roman games took place, always followed by atrocious deaths. Despite some missing parts, the Colosseum has remained standing to this day and is truly impressive! You can visit the first and second floors, the arena and the basement.

ALTAR OF THE FATHERLAND



A symbolic site not only for Rome but for all of Italy.

The monument, also known as the Vittoriano, was erected in honor of King Victor Emmanuel II, a proponent of the Unification of Italy. Its construction in the Capitol area necessitated the demolition of entire medieval quarters. After the end of Fascism, during which time the Vittoriano became only the scene of the regime's demonstrations, the monument once again shone as a symbol of national unity.

THE VATICAN MUSEUMS



The Vatican Museums represent one of the most prestigious and fascinating cultural destinations in the world. The collections collected by various Popes over time offer a unique journey through centuries of art, history and spirituality.

Inside the Vatican Museums you can admire works of art by some of the greatest masters in history. Among the most celebrated masterpieces are the frescoes of the **Sistine Chapel**, created by the genius of Michelangelo with the celebrated Last Judgment fresco that dominates the entire space of the chapel. But the Sistine Chapel is just one of the wonders you can discover during your visit.

NATIONAL MUSEUM OF CASTEL SANT'ANGELO



The monument has had different functions: it has been a mausoleum, a fortress, and a prison. Inside there is a secret tunnel leading from Castel Sant'Angelo to the Vatican, called Passetto di Borgo. The bronze statue of Archangel Michael on the roof commemorates the sighting, in the year 590, of the luminous silhouette of an angel that ended the plague that had mowed down the population of Rome. Hence its name: the Castle of the Angel.

CIRCEO NATIONAL PARK

Boat tour to the Circeo caves

Named one of the Biosphere Reserves by UNESCO, Circeo National Park offers a wide variety of outdoor experiences. Tourist offerings range from trails immersed in the nature of the park, to routes to be taken on the Circeo promontory overlooking the sea, from itineraries dedicated to bikers, to amateur trails accessible to all. The park preserves historical and archaeological finds and offers a rich variety of food and wine products among which the production of mozzarella di Bufala Campana DOP stands out. Given the presence of the sea, scuba diving or sailing trips



can be organized for those who love water sports. Get away from the crowded beaches to discover the turquoise waters that characterize San Felice Circeo with a 2-hour boat tour to marvelous caves.

You'll explore Circeo National Park, which includes as many as 40 fascinating caves steeped in history, and enjoy a refreshing swim in this natural paradise.

VILLA D'ESTE - WORLD HERITAGE SITE



Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2001, it represents a masterpiece of the Italian garden with its impressive concentration of fountains, nymphaea, grottoes, water features and hydraulic music. Cardinal Ippolito II d'Este, after the disappointments of not being elected pope, revived here the splendors of the courts of Ferrara, Rome, and Fointanebleau and revived the magnificence of Villa Adriana. Governor of Tivoli from 1550, he immediately cherished the idea of creating a garden in the slope of the Valle gaudente, but it was not until after 1560 that the architectural and iconological program of the

Villa, conceived by the painter-archaeologist-architect Pirro Ligorio and realized by the court architect Alberto Galvani, became clear. The palace was decorated by the leading figures of late Roman Mannerism.
